

PLATE 50.—WATER TOWERS

Figs. 1 and 2 are section and plan of the water tower at Wallasey, designed and executed under the superintendence of Mr. Robert Rawlinson, C.B. The chromo-lithograph frontispiece is a perspective view of the same.

Figs. 3, 4, and 5 are section, elevation, and plan of the Croydon water tower, from the design of Mr. Baldwin Latham.

Figs. 6 and 7 illustrate the water tower, or rather the building which serves that purpose, at Birkenhead. The structure which carries the tank encloses within its walls the engine-house, the walls of which partially support the tank. This was erected from the design of Mr. J. F. Bateman.
